WHO WE ARE

Ellel Ministries is a non-denominational international Christian ministry that seeks to serve the Body of Christ in two main ways - by offering practical biblical teaching and prayer ministry to those in need of healing and by training and equipping people to become more effective in helping others.

Founded in the North West of England in 1986 by Peter Horrobin, these core principles have never changed, and this dual approach is the hallmark of Ellel Ministries, a ministry that now spans more than 30 countries across the globe.

ELLEL WORK IN PAPUA NEW GUINEA

The Ellel work in Papua New Guinea initially started in 2011 through Pastor Julian R. Kivori, the then Associate Pastor of Boroko Baptist Church. Couple of annual conferences and One Day monthly events were conducted between 2011 and 2014, however, the work was put on halt due to no fulltime workers.



At the end of December 2021 Pastor Julian R Kivori took heed of the call and stepped out in faith with his family from his role as the Senior Pastor of Boroko Baptist Church and moved into being the first fulltime worker of Ellel Ministries Papua New Guinea.

SCRIPTURAL BASIS

Founded on the Scriptural principles of Jesus' model in Luke 9:11 our aim is to:

1. **Welcome** all people with God's love and compassion and without judgement or condemnation.
2. **Teach** biblically based discipleship principles that enable people to be transformed through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and equip them to share the message of hope and healing with others.
3. **Heal** those who are facing struggles in life; emotionally, mentally, physically and spiritually, with a certain knowledge that no person is outside of God's reach for restoration.

OUR NAME

Ellel Ministries takes its name from its first building in England, Ellel Grange, which is near the village of Ellel, in Lancashire. In old English, the name Ellel means 'All hail' which means 'All glory to God.'

In Hebrew, Ellel means 'towards God.' In Mandarin Chinese, it means 'love flowing outwards (愛流).

So Ellel could be said to mean 'All hail, Jesus, All glory to Him' and be expressed as 'Love flowing outwards' into a fallen and broken world, where we are helping people move 'towards God'. It is all for His glory.

VISION

Ellel Ministries Papua New Guinea Inc. (henceforth Ellel PNG) is a legal entity in PNG and is part of the worldwide Ellel Family. We exist to see transformation in Papua New Guinea communities by resourcing, training, and equipping the Church which is the Body of Christ in the area of healing and deliverance.

MISSION

We aim to serve PNG communities in two main ways: (a) by offering practical Biblical teaching and prayer counseling ministry to those in need of healing; and (b) by training and equipping Christians to be more effective in healing others. We do this by welcoming people with God's love and compassion; teaching them about the Kingdom of God; and facilitating God's healing to those in need based on Luke 9:11.

Ellel PNG is, therefore, committed to evangelism, healing, deliverance, discipleship and training (Ephesians 4:12, 2 Timothy 2:2).

OUR SLOGAN

Bringing the Heart of God to the Heart of Man.

BASIC BELIEFS

Ellel PNG holds firmly to the traditional teaching of the Bible with an Evangelical persuasion which forms the foundation upon which we teach and minister.

Basically we believe God is a Trinity. God the Father loves all people. God the Son, Jesus Christ, is Saviour and Healer, Lord and King. God the Holy Spirit indwells Christians and imparts the dynamic power by which they are enabled to continue Christ's ministry. The Bible is the divinely inspired authority in matters of faith, doctrine and conduct, and is the basis for teaching.

OUR FINANCIAL ETHOS

Ellel PNG is not a church that can depend on the weekly tithes and offerings of our members. Our income comes mainly from generous donations and love offerings given during events.

As both a mission and a faith organization, our responsibility is to be obedient to the vision, notwithstanding the cost. This means trusting God for the provision of our financial needs. To move forward in faith requires obedience before provision, trusting that as we are faithful to the vision the provision will be made.

BASIC MINISTRY FOCUS

Ellel PNG exists to serve the local churches in Papua New Guinea and the Melanesian Society by:-

1. Bringing to them Christian ministry and training resources focused on counselling, inner healing, spiritual warfare and discipleship;
2. Training and equipping Christians in Churches to minister deliverance, inner healing, biblical counselling and discipleship;
3. Providing biblical counselling, healing, deliverance and discipleship to those who struggle with spiritual growth and who experience difficulty in prayer, in reading the Word, and in worship;
4. Provide biblical counselling, healing, deliverance and discipleship to those who have personal problems, like trauma, excessive fear, low self-esteem, irrational thinking, uncontrolled emotions, etc;
5. Provide biblical counselling, healing, deliverance and discipleship to those who have mental problems, like stress, depression, memory loss, etc.
6. Provide biblical counselling, healing, deliverance and discipleship to those who have relational problems, for example between spouses, with children, parents, pastors, etc;
7. Provide biblical counselling, healing, deliverance and discipleship to those who struggle with sexuality, repeated accidents, illness and barrenness;
8. Provide biblical counselling, healing, deliverance and discipleship to those who have been involved in cults or in occultic practices;
9. Setting up and conducting Christian conferences, forums, seminars, healing retreats and events for training;
10. Creating and facilitating networks, both real and virtual, that bring pastors and local church leaders together to support, encourage and resource each other;
11. Developing Christian ministry strategies such as Training Schools, Courses, Healing Retreats, Healing Services and other such programs that help the life of the believer through the ministry of the local church.

SHORT COURSES

The name of our short courses is EXPLORE.

EXPLORE is a series of weekend courses designed to train and equip God's people through a journey of transformation. Ellel Ministries aims to bring Word and Spirit together in the application of teaching and ministry.

Together we will find that there is hope and help for the issues we struggle with in everyday life – issues of anxiety, stress, physical pain, gender-based violence, emotional distress, problems in relationships, addictive behaviour, and depression to name just a few. We will also discover what it really means to live with God in a closer relationship, and for God as part of His Kingdom family.

Those who journey through EXPLORE will also be equipped with keys in healing and discipleship to help meet the needs of others. Each of the events in the series will include time for worship, biblical teaching, group discussion, activities, and opportunity for prayer.

The following is a list of courses in the EXPLORE A series...

- The Abundant Christian Life - Exploring God's Foundations for Life
- Deeper Intimacy with God - Exploring the Character and Nature of God
- The Power of Forgiveness – Exploring God's Key to Healing
- Overcoming Rejection and Betrayal - Exploring the Remedy for Rejection
- Exposing Snares of the Enemy 1 - Exploring Healing Through Deliverance
- Healing from Inner Hurt and Pain - Exploring Inner Damage and Healing
- Restoring the Human Spirit - Exploring Restoration of the Human Spirit
- Navigating Difficult Relationships - Exploring God's Design for Relationships
- Overcoming Fear and Anxiety - Exploring the Antidote to Fear and Anxiety
- The Healing Workshop - Exploring Ministry Practice. A practical three to four-day workshop where there is an opportunity to both give and receive ministry from fellow EXPLORE students alongside our Ministry Team.

Our One Day Event is called Understanding Day. These are moments of understanding issues and experiencing times of refreshing that comes when God's Word is made relevant to our day to day living. Our One Day event topics cover:

- Understanding Healing for the Human Spirit
- Understanding Healing of Rejection
- Understanding Ministering into Depression
- Understanding The Christian Response to Freemasonry
- Understanding The Truth about Lies

OUR MINISTRY TEAM

Ellel PNG Ministry Team consist mostly of volunteers who are trained prayer counselors and general helpers. The volunteer trained prayer counselors are of varying ages and backgrounds. All have responded to the call of God on their lives to serve Him voluntarily through Ellel PNG and have a heart to see God restore and bring healing to those who come on our events, and to see them equipped to walk into their God-given destiny.

Pastor Julian & Wife, Rachel

My name is Julian. I come from a mixed Central Province parentage – father from Kivori Kui in the Kairuku-Hiri District and mother from Keapara, Hood Lagoon in the Rigo District. I joined God's full-time ministry in 1993 as a trainee missionary with the then PNG Missionary Association (PNGMA) from a background of automotive electrical.

While serving as a student missionary at the Evangelical Theological Seminary in Indonesia (ETSI) in the year 2000, I experienced greater freedom and healing which led me into a more focused ministry in the area of spiritual conflicts majoring on inner healing and deliverance.

In 2008 I had the opportunity to attend a 10 Day Healing and Discipleship School in Bangkok, Thailand from Bali, Indonesia. It was at this event when God visited me to bring healing to my inner wounds, unforgiveness issues, rejection, sexual sins, grief and generational curses.

As I flew back to Bali after that Meeting, I had an encounter with God on the flight. I prayed, "*Lord God, I thank You for many evangelism and healing crusades conducted throughout PNG; but it seems that no ministry has specifically and professionally addressed the issues of the inner man on issues such as unforgiveness, low self-image, insecurities, sadness, grief, sorrow, self-condemnation, fear of failure, fear of other's opinions, anxiety, worry, perfectionism, self-pity, envy, jealousy, rebelliousness, quarrelling, swearing, hopelessness, aggressive attitudes, occultism, etc and etc. Lord, I want my people to experience the healing and restoration I have experienced in You.*"

After 21 years of conducting inner healing ministry in adhocacy, today, I am humbly honoured, together with my wife, Rachel to officially establish and lead the work of Ellel PNG as the first fulltime staff serving as its Centre Director. I hold onto the conviction that if there is a Children's Ministry (Sunday School) in every Church to reach out to the children, there should be a Prayer Counseling and Healing Ministry in every Church to minister God's healing to the hurting and the wounded of our communities and the society at large.

May God Almighty bless Papua New Guinea!

VOLUNTEER PRAYER COUNSELOR PROFILES

BILL SENEKA



My name is Bill. I heard of the words "Inner-Healing" from a young-travelling servant-of-God who passed through Madang in 2006. It was during his sharing that it dawned on me that there was such an avenue for healing, reconciliation and recovery of a hurting soul. I became an active-participant along with my wife and Ellel Ministries was surely our "go-to" ministry for teaching, healing and deliverance. We went through a healing process using the Ellel Ministries PNG prayer counsellors and attended some teaching in 2015. In 2018, we made commitment and took-up training in the United Kingdom to become Prayer-Counsellors, Mentors and Intercessors. It was a worthy investment of time, monies and personal sacrifices and spent six months at Ellel Pierrepont in a community of participants from Europe, Asia, Australia and PNG.

The training was set in two stages and covered multitude of topics. Of key interest were: Forgiveness, Generational Iniquity, Soul-Ties & Relationships, Sexuality, Inner-Healing & Emotional Wholeness, Freedom from Fear, and from Anger, Healing for Abused People and Discipleship.

I set out to UK with determination and expectation of seeking freedom from many areas, mostly emotional, relationships, sexuality, marriage, family and misfortunes. The journey and its purpose delivered. I returned with my wife and daughter healed, delivered and learnt much the love of the Father, who-so loved the world, gave His Only-Begotten Son; that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life. Life mistakes still surround us today. But it is understanding God's Truth, believing, acting upon it; and the freedom it brings; leading one to forgiveness, reconciliation and restoration to journey-on.

An opportunity was also provided to work in a team environment to support the Ellel International Ministries UK establishment in 2019-20. The COVID-19 pandemic did not help the cause and so we have remained in country. We are hoping to continue-on the work of Ellel PNG and serve the Churches in PNG experience God's healing.

RANU SENEKA



My name is Ranu. Having worked for a global financial institution and holding a position that took care of all my family needs, I became too independent. Hyper - Independence is perhaps the word one could use, as I became a workaholic and an over-achiever. I never said "no" to my employer when asked to work weekends.

Between 2014 and 2015 my secular job became my God. In this period, I was at the highest peak of my corporate journey and I became too proud. Too proud, that whatever I said, whatever I did and whatever I thought, was final and unchangeable both in the work front and the home front.

Ignorant I became towards my husband. I didn't care and bother too much about him when he went out for hours. As time went on, I saw myself drifting and slipping away from my husband's grip. I was always too tired for anything after I arrived home from work (usually it be as late as past 8pm)

Then one day at work after assisting a male customer with his account issues, referred to me by a junior staff, my number was given... My journey to "the horrible pit" began that very day. Cheating on my husband for several months and eventually been found out landed me on a severe emotional and mental impact. The feeling of guilt overtook me, I was helpless and trapped, I was physically and verbally abused, I felt like dying until I attempted suicide.

It was after I was released from hospital, that my husband and I agreed to seek help from a healing ministry, and it was none other than Ellel PNG.

The healing process my wonderful husband and I went through was VERY PAINFUL yet rewarding and worth it in the end. We are so grateful for choosing Christ Jesus to deliver us from ungodly strongholds and restore our marriage.

We later on attended a 6 months' discipleship program in UK in 2018, that brought us into deeper cleansing and deeper understanding of the Love and Heart of our Heavenly Father.

Today I am not the same anymore; I am liberated in Christ Jesus who has done great things in my marriage and in the lives of my children and their children.

Jesus is the Answer for the world today; and I am glad to be part of His Team for PNG!

My name is Stella. I have been involved in church activities and programs for quite a number of years within the local congregation which I am a member of as well as its various ministry arms.

My participation in outreach and camping activities, attending conferences and workshops, serving as a teacher in the Sunday school, parenting the youth and young people, preaching and sharing the Gospel, led me to believe that I was doing very well serving the Lord Jesus Christ.

After attending the 9-Weeks Ellel Flagship School in Perth, Australia, and the NETS School in Pierrepont, United Kingdom in 2014, I began to understand how God healed and gave me freedom on the inside.

In alter calls during crusades, I would bring my problems and issues to the ministers and counsellors, to be prayed over, hoping that I would be free, however, it seemed that I would present the same problems and issues over and over again, and I still felt the same. My name is Ian. It all began for me in 2012 when Ellel Ministries held its second week-long conference here in Port Moresby, PNG through the Boroko Baptist Church.

I attended the week-long event receiving foundational truths from the Biblical teachings. I never realized how damaged my life was, the effects of inner damage caused by trauma and accidents, my own sins, others ungodly influences, generational sins and iniquities, to name a few. These were very evident in my life and were reflected in my physical body through the behaviours that had a great grip to my spiritual growth over the years.

I responded to the call for prayer and received personal prayer counselling from qualified, equipped, gifted and anointed prayer ministers who prayed into the different issues as mentioned. I felt a release from the bondages. I also received healing to my inner struggles, to my emotions, my will, and my human spirit.

I was confused, but I followed the prompting of the Holy Spirit and told my husband to drive me to Boroko Baptist Church. I asked to see a Pastor and I was led to Pastor Julian whom I did not know. I told Pastor Julian that I was confused. I did not know why I was there as my Church was just next door, St. Joseph's Catholic. Pastor Julian and his wife ministered to me and a week later Pastor Julian led me to the Lord.

My name is Kaluweh. This is a personal testimony of how the Ellel Ministry has helped me identify with the root cause of my anger and bitterness.

As a Christian, I thought I was okay until I attended Ellel Ministry's first conference in Port Moresby in 2011. The Biblical Teachings helped me identify and deal with the root cause of my anger and bitterness, hurt and expressed anger in my life that has fuelled my past conduct and behaviour.

After attending the Ellel Conference, I was keen to learn more about personal healing and restoration by attending the Nine (9) Weeks Flagship Program in Perth, Australia. The program offered many more and deeper biblical insights on various topics addressing hidden and more profound issues of my life.

The teachings and prayer sessions revealed events in my life that influenced my conduct and behaviour, including when I was abandoned as an eight-year-old when my mum left me with my Dad and two elder siblings and took two younger siblings with her. and felt a release come upon me, and I felt the relief and peace in my heart. I knew that very moment I had been delivered of my anger and bitterness towards my parents, especially my mum.

I am grateful to God for an amazing life-changing experience in my life. Although still on the journey of healing, I see God's transforming power still at work in my life. I am glad to be part of this Ministry praying for people to find their healing in the Lord Jesus too.
